### **TYPES OF SESSIONS**

Your proposal should fit one of these categories so that participants can choose the type of session that appeals to their needs and interests. Keep in mind that the purpose of this conference is to provide teachers with ideas that can translate into better teaching, researching or assessment practices in the classroom.

**a. Workshop (45 minutes):** The presenters apply a meaningful task(s) or technique(s) with the group of participants so they can replicate this experience in their classrooms. A brief theoretical introduction precedes the workshop.

#### b. Paper Sessions (45-minutes)

A paper involves a 25-minute presentation on a research project related to the central topic of the conference. Afterwards the audience will have 20 minutes to ask questions to the presenters.

#### c. Lectures (50 minutes)

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The presenters discuss a theoretical or practical issue closely related to the conference topic (40 minutes). At the end, the participants have 10 minutes to ask questions.
